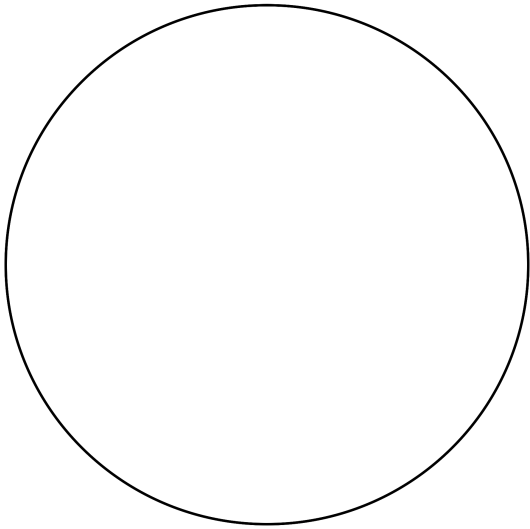


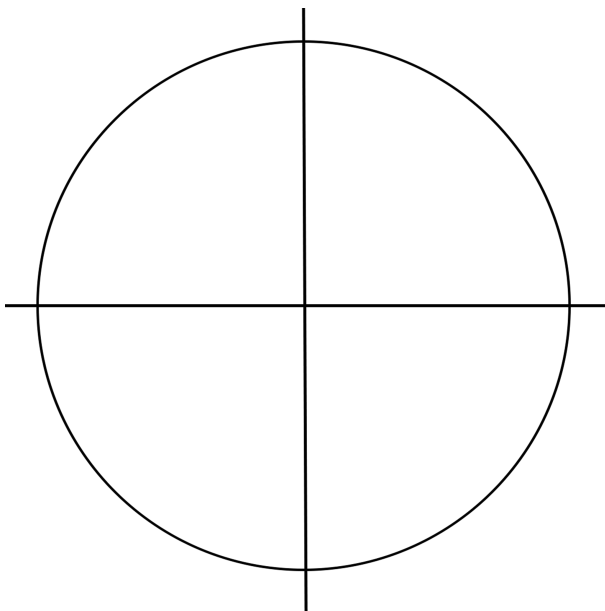
Head Tutorial

This is a quick tutorial on drawing a head from the front view.

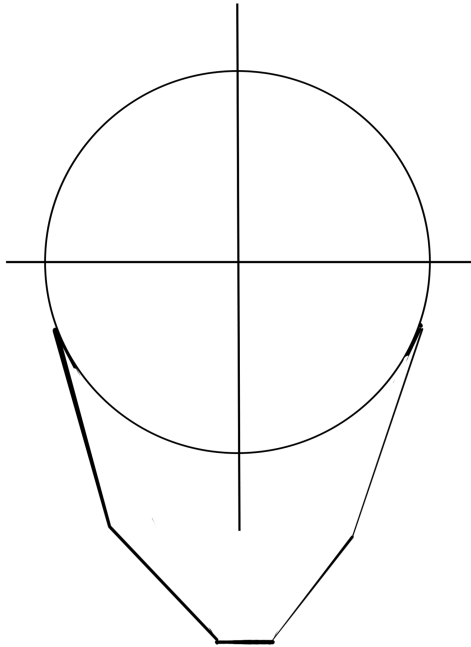
First we start with drawing a circle.



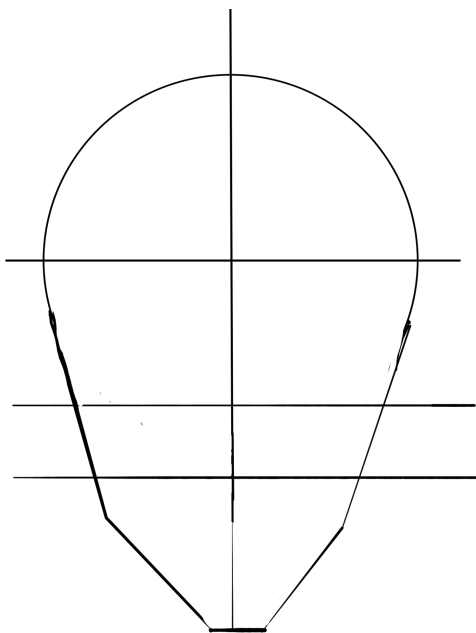
Draw a cross through the circle to mark the eyebrow line and facial center.



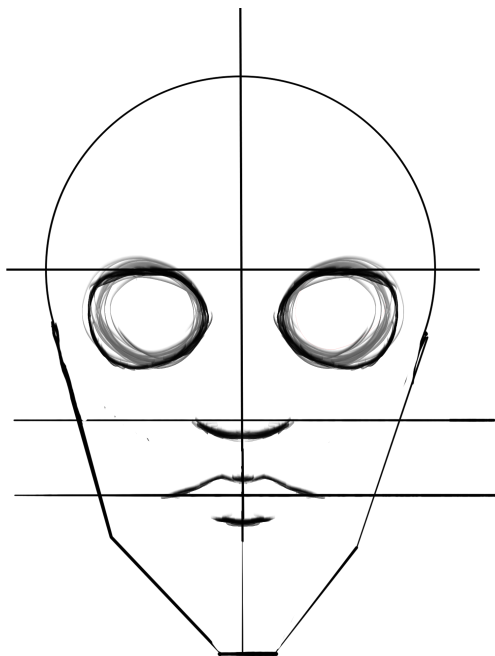
Lightly sketch the jawline's angle and shape, ensuring it complements the face and aligns with the ear and chin. Consider the character's age and gender, as a sharp jaw can appear strong, while a softer one can seem gentler. Refine the lines until the jaw looks natural.



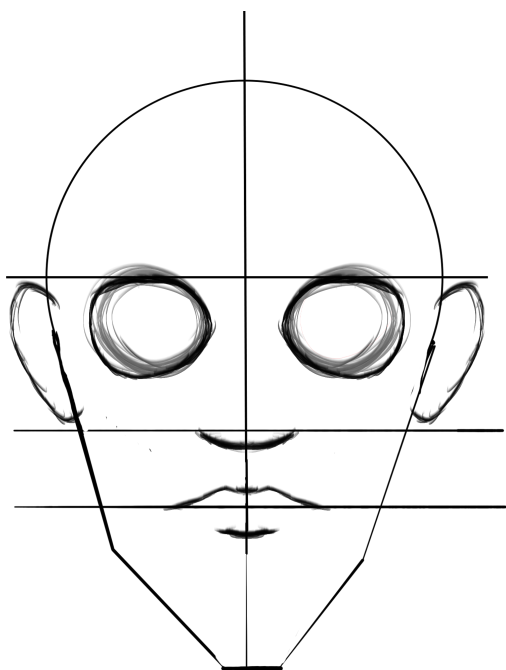
Draw a horizontal line halfway down the face. This line will mark the position for the base of the nose. Add another line directly below the previous one to indicate placement of the mouth.



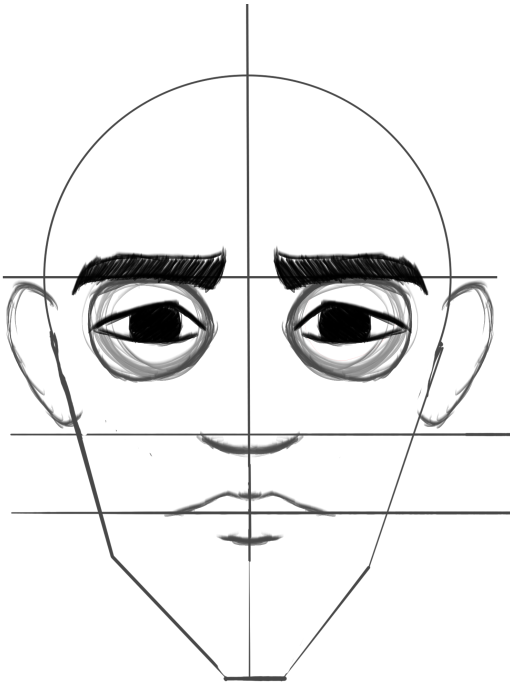
Lightly sketch the eyesocket, nose, and lips. Don't add too much detail at this stage; keep it rough. You will refine these features later.



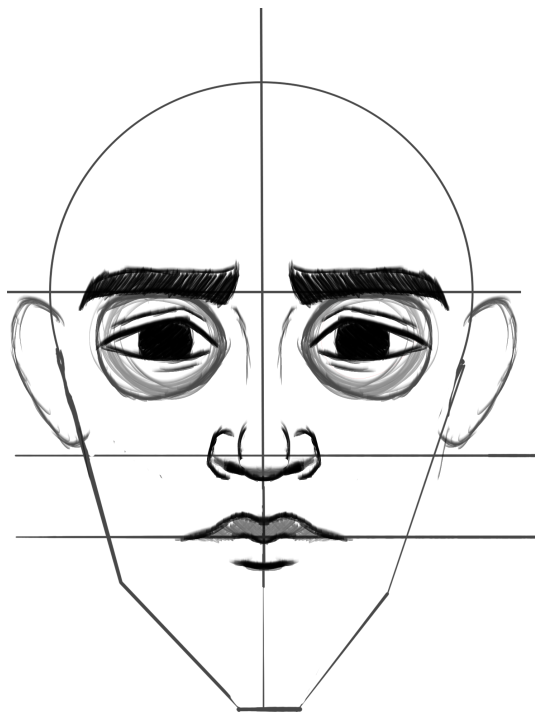
The ears are typically aligned with the eyebrows at the top, and the bottom of the nose at the bottom.



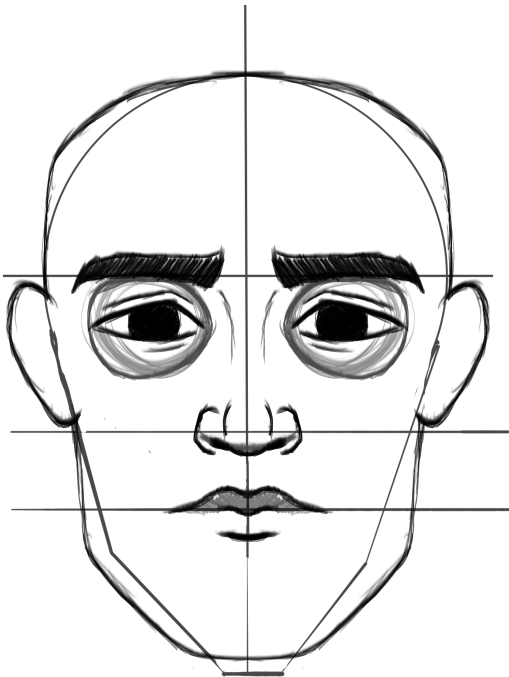
Draw eyes inside the eye sockets, and add eyebrows above them.



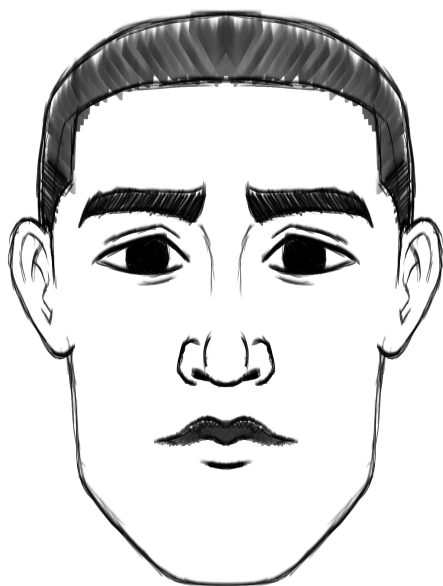
Enhance the mouth and nose with additional details.



Now define the shape of the head and jaw to your liking.



Enhance the face by adding hair or facial hair.



This is only one way to draw a head. Remember that you can adjust the guidelines to create different facial features and looks. Use a reference image and try to replicate it.



Bonus Task

Find a photo of a face that interests you. Then try to draw the face you have chosen using what you have learnt.
